Isaac

The aim of this session is to: look at the life of Isaac and see how important our relationships and faith are.

Verses:

Genesis: Genesis 21:1-7, Genesis 25:19-23, Genesis 26:1-5 and 28:13-15



Rebekah and Isaac were excited!
Instead of just one baby, they had twins!
They named them Esau and Jacob.
But even though the boys were twins, they were nothing alike.

Read These Passages and complete these questions:

Genesis 21:1-7, Genesis 25:19-23, Genesis 26:1-5 and 28:13-15

Genesis 21:1-7

- How old were Abraham and Sarah when Isaac was born?
- Why did they call him Isaac (which means "she laughed")?
- How did Abraham and Sarah feel?

Genesis 25:19-23

- Who did Isaac Marry?
- Why did he ask God for a child?
- What does this show you about Isaac's faith?
- How did God answer Isaac's prayer?

Genesis 26:1-5 and 28:13-15

- What promise did God make to Isaac?
- Why was God keeping his promise to Isaac and Abraham?
- How was Isaac part of the promise that God gave his son?
- How did God bless Isaac through his children?



Facts about Isaac

Isaac is Abraham and Sarah's son

His Wife's name is Rebecca

Isaac had two children Jacob and Esau

Isaac is the only patriarch whose name was not changed.

Isaac's name means "He will laugh"

He died when he was 180 years old
